



How to Create an Account

To use GrantGenie's tools, you must have an account. To create an account, navigate to https://app2.grantgenie.com.

Select your organization type and click "Next" to create an account.



Enter your information and click "Create Account."






How to Use the Proposal Ideas Generator Tool

Before using the Grantmakers Proposal Ideas Generator Tool, we recommend users gather the following information:

- Organization name
- The zip code for the proposed project
- List of environmental issues affecting the community (e.g., air quality, climate change)
- 3-5 bullet points describing the main problem or need that the organization wants to address with this project
- 3-5 bullet points describing the proposed solution and how it meaningfully contributes to solving the problem
- High-level list of tactics/strategies for the proposed project (e.g., Advocacy, Research)
- Organization name and website for the lead applicant
- Information about project partner(s), including each organization's name, website, and role in the project




How to Use the Grantmakers Proposal Ideas Generator Tool

After logging in, click "Tools" on the Home page.



Select "Grantmakers Proposal Ideas Generator" and click Next.






How to Use the Grantmakers Proposal Ideas Generator Tool


Enter your organization's website and click "Fetch."

Review and edit the organization information after the AI populates the fields. Then click "Next" at the bottom.

If your organization doesn't have a website, you can add the information manually.



Enter the City and State code for your project's location and click "Ask ai." The AI will populate the project information. Review and edit the fields and click "Next."







List the challenges that you hope to address and potential solutions you've identified. Select the project duration and the tactic/strategies for the project.




The Al-assisted tool will generate a draft Project Description. Review and click the pencil if you want to edit the text. Click "Next."






How to Use the Grantmakers Proposal Ideas Generator Tool

The AI-assisted tool will generate draft Project Activities/Milestone Schedule/Anticipated Outcomes. Review and click the pencil if you want to edit the text. When you've finished, click "Next."



Enter information for the Lead Applicant and any Partners. Click "Add+" if you want to add more than one Partner. Click "Next" when you've finished adding Partners.






How to Use the Grantmakers Proposal Ideas Generator Tool Cont'd

The Al-assisted tool will generate a summary of the Lead Applicant and Project Partners. Review and click the pencil if you want to edit the text. When finished, click "Next."




How to Use the Organizational Overview Tool

Before using the Organizational Overview Tool, we recommend users gather the following information:

- Organization name
- Examples of the organization's past achievements and/or successful campaigns that benefited the community they serve
- Information about the organization's historical connection to the underserved community, including 3-4 examples of past efforts on behalf of the underserved community, 2-3 examples of how the organization has engaged with residents and other stakeholders, and 2-3 bullets about the history of the organization's involvement in the community
- Any relevant documents that may demonstrate the organization's programmatic capacity (e.g., strategic plan, publication, screenshot of website pages)
- The zip code for the proposed project
- List of environmental issues affecting the community (e.g., air quality, climate change)








How to Use the Organizational Overview Tool

Select "Organizational Overview Tool" and click Next.




How to Use the Organizational Overview Tool

Enter examples of your organization's past achievements and/or successful campaigns that benefited the communities you serve.











How to Use the Organizational Overview Tool

At this time, you can only upload PDFs.




The tool pulls out summaries of different sections in the document. Select the sections you want to include and click the pencil to edit the relevant text. Click "Next" when you're done.






